Overview

This qualification is aimed at individuals in a wide range of work environments where they are required to undertake a changing range or a limited number of Healthcare and Social Care tasks.

For example:

- workers in community or care home settings may be required to carry out a limited number of tasks, their job role may not enable them to meet the standards of a full Healthcare and Social Care Diploma but their industry requires them to be able to demonstrate their competence and skills; or
- workers may be required to have a range of healthcare support skills to be able to work with Nurses, Physiotherapists and other health professionals who are providing care for, or carrying out health promotion and prevention with older people and those with long-term conditions

Learning Outcomes

To achieve the qualification candidates must complete a number of units from a wide range of optional units relating to healthcare and social care tasks, there are no mandatory units. A candidate's job role will help to determine which units a candidate undertakes.

Candidates will work with an assessor to select relevant units and complete a portfolio of evidence that confirms they have met the requirements of the qualification.
